

NAME

any -- match character against string

SYNOPSIS

```
any(c1,s1)
char c1, *s1;
```

DESCRIPTION

any returns an integer indicating the success or failure of the pattern match. If the value returned is zero the match was a success. If the value returned is -1 the match was a failure. This function indicates if the character c1 matches any character in the string s1.

c1 a character to be searched.

s1 a string of characters used as a pattern.

The pattern, s1, can be any null terminated string of characters. Repeated characters in s1 are ignored. The pattern string "Mississippi" is equivalent to the pattern string "iMps".

If c1 is null, the function returns a -1.

If s1 is empty, the function returns a -1.

If the character c1 is found in s1, the function returns a zero, otherwise, the function returns a -1.
