NAME

xusr — extract user core image from process core dump

SYNOPSIS

xusr [*srcfile*] [*corefile*]

DESCRIPTION

Xusr extracts a core dump file into "core" from the process dump file specified by *srcfile*. *Xusr* knows about the format of the dump file as dumped by the process manager or by *kdb* (see *kdb(e)*). It creates a "core" file in *core* unless a second argument *corefile* is specified. The format of the "core" file is suitable for debugging by *adb*. This is useful for extracting a core file image from a dump produced in "/cdmp/unix" by the *pkill* program.
